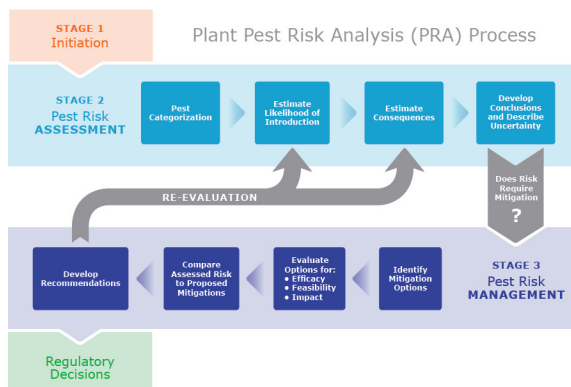


# Food Safety Network SPS Plant Health Courses
