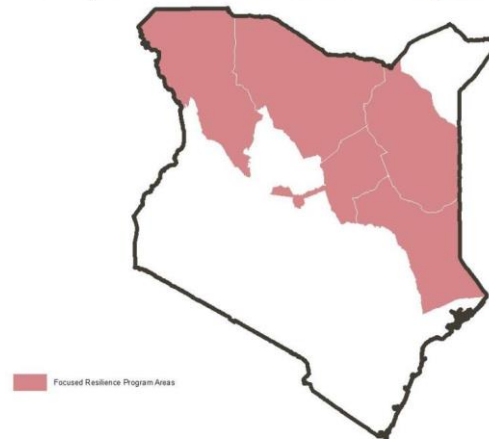

Depth of Poverty (mean gap in %)	25%	20%
Moderate or severe hunger (prevalance)	55%	44%
Global Acute Malnutrition (prevalance)	13%	< 10%
